With the win the Shockers advance to their sixth consecutive MVC Tournament final on Sunday at 2 p.m. The Shocks are seeking their third consecutive tournament title and will face the winner of the Drake/Creighton match.

WSU clinched the doubles point against SIU with a win by Lutfiana Budiharto and Valerie Brockman over Vishakha Sheoran and Anita Lee in the No. 3 match, 9-7. Delia Damaschin and Carla Venticinque won the No. 2 doubles match, 8-2 over Korey Love and Anastacia Simons for the Shocks other victory.

Damaschin clinched the match win for the Shockers with her defeat of Jennifer Dien, 6-4, 6-3 in the No. 3 match. Veronika Blaskova and Montse Blasco Fernandez each continued their strong play with wins in the No. 2 and No. 5 matches, respectively.
