Head Coach Tanya Warren

On play of Amber Kirschbaum:

"She's had a very good last month of the season. She's finally healthy and she's really been putting in the extra time to get better. She realizes her career is coming to a close and wants to do everything she can to make it special."

On tomorrow's game against Wichita State:

"We can't let their defense create their offense. They are very good and are well coached. They defend and we are looking forward to this challenge tomorrow."

On getting back to the semi-finals:

On hitting the big three:

Head Coach Teri Moren

On ISU's ability to come back after a slow start:

"It took a lot in the first five or seven minutes just to get any kind of flow. I thought we took some tough shots. Needless to say, this is a group that has battled back, so we, as a staff, were waiting for that to happen—and it did."

On Jacqui Kalin:

"Pretty much any time you need a basket, she can go find one for you, or she facilitates so well she can find somebody else that can get a basket for you."

On Jacqui Kalin:

"She's a great player with a ton of experience under her belt. She's obviously their go-to player and she finished this game out. I feel next year it's going to be Anna Munn in our case."

On needing to create opportunities with defensive effort:

"Our defense was kind of slow in the beginning. We started to pick it up in the second half. That's what we really needed to do and I think that's what got us back in the game.
