

CREIGHTON QUOTES –

Jim Flanery on the win-

"We couldn't have written a better start. We were really focused and had a really good understanding of what we needed to do early and that was important. We were down 6-0 two minutes in the game last night; today we're up 8-0 right away. Credit Wichita, for a young team they stayed composed after we pushed [the lead] out to 18 [points] in that first half and came back, made a run at the end of the half, and started the second half well. I thought our kids responded to their challenge. We had a lot of people play well. I thought our bench was outstanding. We carried what we did early in through the second half."

Jim Flanery on the game plan for Wichita-

"Tonight we saw a team that really extended out defensively, and also a team where Kellie (Nelson) has a little bit more of a size advantage, and so our plan was to throw the ball inside to Kelli some, but also put the ball on the floor. We talked a lot about meeting passes. We need to be a team that relies a little bit less on the three."

Kellie Nelson on three point shooting-

"We had open shots the first [game]; I love it when my teammates take those threes. We have a really good three-point shooting team, so I'll be on those boards and I'll get those misses, but we really worked the ball. I think we were really patient this time and they found me. It's a credit to them because I got good passes and most of my shots were layups."

Sam Schuett on Wichita's defense-

"[Wichita] has a really scrappy defense. They battle every possession, they gamble on some plays, but they get turnovers a lot of the time. We knew we were going to come in and it was going to be a battle. They have some phenomenal athletes and it was important for us to box out. I think we did a good job on rebounding today. That was really key for us."
